Job Description: Laborer

General Description: The laborer's job is to assist the jobsite supervisor in the daily operations of a job site.

Major Job Activities/Responsibilities: Provides assistance to the job supervisor and rest of the crew in moving and organizing materials and tools on the site, demolition, jobsite setup, and cleanup. You must be able to understand verbal and written instruction about jobsite tasks and safety issues. You must be able to keep pace with the prevailing flow of work on a jobsite. You must be willing to do the lion's share of grunge work, be able to do heavy lifting, and fit yourself into tight spaces. You must be of a cooperative disposition and a strong communicator and quick learner. You will be responsible for getting yourself to and from job sites. We encourage carpooling when possible.

Required Tools: Tool belt, tape, utility knife, framing hammer, speed square.

Required Attire: Work gloves, appropriate work clothing and footwear.

Skill Set:

- Ability to read written instructions.
- Ability to work within the company safety plan and within OSHA safety standards.
- Able to lift and carry at least 50 pounds.

General Notes: Previous experience on a jobsite is preferred but not required. This position is an excellent opportunity for younger folks who are interested in the field of natural building and want a paid opportunity to learn. All of the company owners who you will work with also teach workshops and will make time for you to learn while doing. We are a growing company and there will certainly be room for more responsibilities and pay increases as skills develop.

Don't be deceived though, as one of our mentors always said, "90% of natural building is heavy lifting."

Compensation: \$12 / hour. Anticipate 30-40 hours a week.
